Disasters can strike at any time and being prepared for these and other unexpected events is critical to saving lives. Each one of us has a responsibility to understand the risk natural and man-made disasters pose to our communities, and to recognize we each have a role in preparing for these events.

We have a duty to build a Culture of Preparedness in which our neighbors, families and friends are ready for any disaster event, and to make our communities safer, stronger, and better prepared.



CERT Basic Training - A free instructor-led course consisting of 20 hours of instruction on topics such as Personal and Family Preparedness, Earthquake Preparation, Team Organization, Medical Operations and Triage, Damage Assessment, Fire Suppression, Utility Control, and Light Search & Rescue. You may choose either the Saturday morning track of four classes, or the Tuesday night track consisting of six classes. Both classes conclude with a skills exercise held on a Saturday morning.

Continuing Education - CERT members that have completed the Basic Training are given the opportunity to expand their knowledge, hone their skills, and learn how to participate in a broader range of volunteer activities through the Continuing Education program.

The Martinez Area CERT offers these Continuing Education classes to CERT members:

First Aid/AED/ Head to toe assessment – Learn basic life saving techniques and first-aid

CERT Basic Radio Communications – Learn the basics of radio communications and how it can help in CERT response.

Incident Command System – Review of roles that includes setting up and command post.

Traffic and Crowd Control – Taught using CERT Curriculum, include classroom and field practice.

Online / Self-Paced Continuing Education

IS-317 Introduction to CERT - This online overview of CERT Basic Training can be a great refresher for existing CERT members.

CERT Search and Rescue Tutorial - This online tutorial allows CERT-trained individuals to review and refresh their skills in size up and search and rescue techniques.

CERT Animal Response - The modules teach emergency preparedness for situations involving animals that you may encounter in performing your broader CERT response functions.

National Incident Management System - IS-100, 200, 700, 800 - Supplement your CERT basic training with online classes from FEMA. These classes will give you a greater understanding of how to use CERT organizational principles and how you fit into the emergency response system.
